1. Applicability

- 1.1. This Policy applies to all volunteers, officials and members of The Bournemouth Lions Wheelchair Rugby
- 1.2. This policy does not apply to infringements by players of the technical regulations of Wheelchair Rugby, which are dealt with under the International Rules for the Sport of Wheelchair Rugby, published by the International Wheelchair Rugby Federation.

2. Policy

- 2.1. The Bournemouth Lions Wheelchair Rugby strives to operate effectively and to provide the best possible service to the sport of Wheelchair Rugby in the United Kingdom. This is in line with standards of performance and conduct expected of all officials, volunteers and members.
- 2.2. The Bournemouth Lions Wheelchair Rugby adopts a zero-tolerance approach to doping, and performance enhancing drugs, in line with GBWR Protocols.
- 2.3 Disciplinary rules and procedures will be applied whenever a member is suspected of taking performance enhancing drugs and is in breach of this policy.
